Online Course is a course delivered using the Internet. Students and instructors do not meet face-to-face. As with a campus class, assignments and exams have due dates. Typically, communication and course content are delivered using the Blackboard course management system. Students don't have to be online at a certain time every day, but will be expected to log on to the course website regularly and respond to online discussions. Online courses are designated in the schedule with a "W" (for example, ENGL 101 C01W).

A hybrid course is a combination of face-to-face and online instruction. Hybrid courses provide specific dates and times for face-to-face classroom meetings, with additional course content typically delivered online using the Blackboard course management system. It is important to check with the instructor to see how classroom time and online assignments are blended together.

Hybrid courses are designated in the schedule with an "A" (for example, ENGL 101 C01A).
