Welcome to CSI/IDAA's Summer Dance Mini Workshop! The following information will be helpful as you make plans for the camp. Most importantly, please see the attached class schedule. Drop Off

- ❖ Those students who are staying in the dorm need to check in on Friday, July 25 from 7:00-8:00 p.m. No meals will be served to Mini Workshop students Friday evening.
- ❖ Local students and those commuting to CSI will check in Saturday, July 26 at 8:30 a.m. – 9 a.m. in the CSI Fine Arts Auditorium.

Pick Up

- ❖ Those students who are staying in the dorm need to check out on Saturday, July 26 from 5:30-7:00 p.m.
- ❖ Parents of local students and those commuting to CSI will need to be at CSI Dorms to pick up their children by 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 26 after the Mini Camp pizza party.

Activities

Students staying in the dorms will automatically take part in scheduled activities on Friday night. Off-campus students who wish to take part in Friday night activities are more than welcome. (Please see a Dorm Mom upon check-in if you want more information on your off-campus student participating in evening activities.)

- ❖ Friday, July 25
 - After dorm check-in, mini campers will meet the Dorm Moms and go on a campus walk followed by a fashion in the Fine Arts Auditorium at 8:00 p.m.

Meals

Meals are being provided only for those staying in the dorm. Local students who are commuting need to eat breakfast before they come; they may bring a sack lunch, including a drink (or two) or pre-purchase camp lunches for \$6.

Here are a few things you need to know about the camp:

1. Once you arrive on campus, you are not to leave the area of the Fine Arts Building without permission. Dorm students stay with the Dorm Mothers at all times.
2. All classes will be held in the Auditorium in the Fine Arts Building.
3. The first class will begin promptly at 9:15 a.m.
4. Please wear leotard and tights – do not wear “extra” clothes in class.
5. Wear a skirt, shorts, or slacks for “cover-up” outside of the classroom.
6. Students are encouraged to take all classes. Students must remain in the auditorium and observe classes in which they are not participating.
7. Bring your dance shoes! If you don't have tap shoes, other shoes will do; jazz shoes are OK for ballet & vice versa.

ROOMS All dorms are triple occupancy (especially this year due to construction). We will honor roommate preference where possible. When no roommate preference is made, the camp will assign a roommate to you.
