

Dual Credit Transferability (Known Issues)

The following is an unofficial list of colleges and universities that do not accept dual credit based transcripts for transfer. These institutions may exclude all transfer credits or might exclude college credits earned while a student is still in high school. It is always a good practice to contact the registrar of the college or university you are interested in attending and ascertain if they accept transfer credits, and if there are any institutional restrictions relating to college credits earned through dual credit programs:

1. Babson College (MA)
2. Columbia University (NY)
3. Duke University (NC) Note – College credits taken and not dual listed on a HS transcript may be considered for transfer.
4. Furman (SC)
5. Princeton University (NJ)
6. Univ. of Puget Sound (WA)
7. Whitman College (WA)
8. Brown University (RI)
9. Georgetown University (DC) Note – Transfer credits limited in specific graduate/advanced degree programs.
10. University of Michigan (MI) Note – Transfer credits limited in specific graduate/advanced degree programs.
