- ✦ Complete as much of your homework before you come to get help and bring your book, calculator and assignment with you to get tutoring.

- ✦ Be patient. With drop in tutoring the tutor will help students as they arrive.
- ✦ The Learning Assistance Center is a great place to study, however the tutor is not there to sit and work through each homework problem.
- ✦ Tutoring is not a substitute for attending class. Any new material should be taught by your instructor.
- ✦ Tutors cannot help with take home tests.
- ✦ Remember a tutor is a student too. They will not have all the answers.
