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Licensed Practical Nurses practice in long term care facilities, physician offices, rural hospitals, and administrative offices. LPN's completing the program at CSI graduate with IV Therapy Certification as well as Charge Nurse Certification. The Practical Nursing program is approved by the Idaho Board of Nursing and Idaho Division of Professional Technical Education. Upon satisfactory completion of the PN program the graduate is eligible to write the NCLEX-PN. Applying to this program is a separate application process from applying to the College or declaring your major.
