LOANS AND SCHOLARSHIPS: There were four scholarships totaling \$250 and two loans totaling \$175, approved on MOTION by Mr. Coleman seconded by Mr. Babcock. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT we have recontracted with the faculty and staff for the next fiscal year. Five employees have retired and three have resigned, all other employees are returning for the next year.

Dr. Taylor reported that the exploratory work is progressing on the thermal well and federal funding is actively being sought.

Dr. Taylor reported that during the month of March there were 27,285 visitors on campus.

An evaluation team from the State Department of Vocational Education will be on campus for the remainder of the week, analyzing our Vo-Ed program.

We are considering the possibility of making some changes in our dormitory to accommodate more women residents.

We have explored with HUD the possibility of some cottage or bungalow type housing units. We will continue to pursue this possibility.

Graduation at the College is scheduled for May 12.
