TREASURER'S REPORT FOR February was accepted upon MOTION by Dr. Lehrman.

DISBURSEMENTS totaled \$253,372.16 and a contract to pay \$3,000 to Ben Madron  
for travel expense to attend school in Salt Lake City over the  
next three months was added to the disbursements.

transfer of funds and acknowledged the February payrolls.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Ten scholarships totaling \$1150 were approved on MOTION  
by Dr. Scholes.

CONTRACTS: Jerry Meyerhoeffer requested permission to start issuing  
contracts to employees at the same figure as last year.  
The request was approved on MOTION by Mr. Blastock.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Jerry Meyerhoeffer reported that the House of  
Representatives has held up the tuition bill for junior  
colleges on a MOTION by Representative Boyd. He has contacted  
Representative Boyd and is assured of his support when the bill  
comes up for third reading tomorrow. It appears that an omnibus  
revenue bill to increase state revenue will be considered prior  
to action by the Joint Finance Appropriations Committee.

Jerry will be attending the Idaho Task Force on Education Meeting in  
Boise on Tuesday and Wednesday. They will be discussing the  
governance and finance of community colleges.


PRESIDENT'S REPORT CONTINUED:

We are currently making changes in the lobby to accommodate student offices.


Milt Smith has been asked to make recommendations on resource development and has requested an operating budget for the same for FY 84.
