MINUTES OF October 21, 1996 were approved as written on MOTION by Dr. Charles Lehrman. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

TREASURERS REPORT: The Treasurer's Report for October was approved on MOTION by Dr. Charles Lehrman. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

BIDS:

1. The Board approved the low bid of Global Printer Supplies of Boulder, Colorado in the amount of \$17,688.00 for three computerized projection systems on MOTION by Donna Brizee. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

Funding for this purchase is from a vocational grant.

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<u>November 18, 1996</u>
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2. The Board approved the lowest responsible bid of Idaho Bus Sales of Jerome, Idaho in the amount of \$103,032.00 for two busses on MOTION by Dr. Charles Lehrman. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

Eighty percent of this purchase is funded by a grant from the Idaho Department of Transportation and twenty percent from budgeted capital outlay funds from Trans IV.

3. The Board approved the sole bid of Gym Outfitters of Boise, Idaho in the amount of \$28,552.50 for the specified gym equipment on MOTION by Bill Babcock. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

Funding for this purchase is from the physical education addition construction account.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

- 1. The Board approved the election results from Twin Falls and Jerome Counties certifying that Dr. Thad Scholes was reelected for another six-year term of Trustee for the College of Southern Idaho on MOTION by Bill Babcock. Affirmative vote was unanimous.
- 2. The Board was reorganized as follows:

The above organization was approved on MOTION by Dr. Thad Scholes. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

3. Skyler Rubel reviewed plans for the twenty-two thousand square foot South Central Health District building to be built on campus. The Board approved the siting and general design and appearance. They expressed concern about the appearance of the green, cable suspended awnings over the windows. Sklyer Rubel agreed to provide the Board with another drawing and design with the awnings removed for their review.

Mr. Rubel advised the Board that he was working with the City of Twin Falls to address all code issues including storm water retention from the building and parking lots. It was pointed out that this retention basin would have to be limited on the east side of the building so that it would not impact future College parking lot expansion.

Dr. Chuck Parker thanked the Board for allowing the building to be built on campus. He also advised the Board that a groundbreaking ceremony was tentatively planned for the second Wednesday in March of 1997. The building is scheduled for completion by late December of 1997.

- 4. Dr. Claudeen Buettner and Marilyn Blackburn discussed the agreement with the Idaho State Board of Nursing which removed the nursing program from conditional status. They also discussed the programs and offerings of the Health Sciences and Human Services department.
- 5. Lynn Irons and Jane Brumbach made a presentation to the Board concerning the College's involvement in the Adult Basic Education program. They discussed the Idaho Board of Education's `Seventy Percent Committee' and how we were already serving many members of this target group.
- 6. The President and Board:
- 1. Commended Annette Jenkins for being recognized by the Twin Falls Chamber of Commerce for volunteerism.
- 2. Recognized Cindy Bond for receiving a national award for excellence for directors of Small Business Development Centers.
- 3. Commended the men's and women's track teams for their outstanding performance at nationals.
