1. The Board approved the low bid of BJR Microsystems of
Boise, Idaho in the amount of \$38,368 for thirty two
computers on MOTION by Dr. Thad Scholes. Affirmative vote
was unanimous.

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PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

1. Dr. Ken Campbell, Dr. John Martin and Mike Mason briefed the Board on the search for a new campus software system. They advised the Board that the cost of the client server software, equipment, conversion of existing data and implementation of the new software could cost as much as \$500,000.

The Board approved the administration continuing the process with the issuance of a Request For Proposal (RFP) for the new system.

2. Mike Mason advised the Board that the Memorandum of Understanding with the Idaho Food Quality Assurance Institute for the use of the Quality Assurance Lab is still being worked out. The remaining issue involves the procedures to be followed in the event the Idaho Food Quality Assurance Institute ceases to exist.

3. The President advised the Board that an addendum was being added to the agreement with the Boys and Girls Club to insure that the building would revert to the college in the event that it was vacated for over sixty days. Jeff Duggan and Robert Alexander are working on the issue.

4. The President informed the Board that the City of Twin Falls Police Department will make a proposal for providing security services for the campus. The Twin Falls County Sheriff's Department will also be making a proposal. The President said that some of our security staff will elect to become deputized and some will not.

Dick Sterling and Darryl Cameron will work out the specific areas we want to have covered in an agreement.

5. The President advised the Board of the proposal to renovate the tower. The plan involves removing the deteriorating wings and leaving the main structural beams. The project is planned to be completed this summer.

6. The President reviewed the Desert-Canyon building connection project. The connector building would provide space for the second year autobody program. Cabinet making would move into the old autobody space and apprenticeship programs would move into the vacated cabinet making space. The overall project is estimated to cost approximately \$325,000.

The Board approved the project on MOTION by Bill Babcock. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

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
6. (continued) The project will receive \$60,000 from the Plant Facility Fund. The remaining balance will be transferred in from the General Motors account over the next four years.

7. The President reviewed plans to build an addition onto the Aspen building with the Board. The approximately twelve thousand square foot addition is estimated to cost nearly 1.4 million dollars. The building will house our growing allied health programs.

8. The Board moved the January Board meeting from Monday, January 26, 1998 to Tuesday, January 20, 1998. The move was made due to a conflict with our legislative schedule.


9. The President advised the Board that Jim Woods and Bill West were team teaching a telecommunications anthropology course via the internet for Idaho State University.



Re: Computer Bid

Based upon a review of the bids by Dr. Ken Campbell and Gary Baum, I recommend we accept the low bid of BJR Microsystems, Inc. of Boise, Idaho in the amount of \$38,368.00 for thirty two computers in thirteen different configurations.

This purchase will upgrade computers in the business office and computer center, provide fifteen new computers for the vocational program, one for athletics, two for academic instruction, two for outreach centers and one for planning and development.

Funding for this purchase is from various departmental budgets.

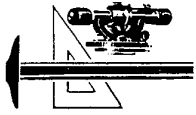
