HOKEY POKEY and MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS****DESCRIPTION OF AWARDS**

The College of Southern Idaho Department of Music will award up to \$100,000.00 in scholarships to deserving individuals for the 2020-2021 academic school year. Each scholarship will pay for a portion of undergraduate resident tuition and fees for the fall and spring semesters. Recipients must be full-time students and actively participate in the Music Department. Students looking for a challenging and rewarding musical experience are encouraged to apply. **This application must be accompanied by the requested additional information.**

AUDITIONS

In order that the Music Department may guide and counsel students more effectively, we ask that all students applying for a music scholarship perform an audition. Please keep in mind: auditions are not torture sessions. We use an audition to enable you to win a scholarship, not to eliminate you. We ask that you **perform two selections: something slow and something fast.** Memorization is encouraged but not required. You may also be asked to play scales and sight-read. If needed, you may perform portions of your selections. An accompanist will be provided if requested on the audition form.

Students living within a distance of 150 miles from Twin Falls are expected to audition in person. Those living farther than 150 miles may submit a link to a video recording (i.e. YouTube, Vimeo, etc.), although an in person audition is preferred.

Auditions for music scholarships will be held on Saturday, **March 7, 2020 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m** in Room 119 of the Fine Arts Building. **Audition is by appointment only.** Students must contact the Music Department by Thursday, March 5 for an appointment. - * On an attached sheet of paper: please detail what instruments (or voice) you have studied, how long you have studied each, and whether you have had private or class lessons. Describe what training you've had in the theory or rudiments of music. Outline your musical experiences: performances, ensemble membership, contests, recitals, honors, etc. If you are a continuing student, give the details of your music course work and experience.
- * Official transcripts from high school and/or colleges you have attended. Current cumulative grade point average should be clearly defined.
- * In typed form, describe the difference music has made in your life, why you chose it as a course of study, and what music means to you.
