

CSI Child Care Funds Available for Currently Enrolled Parenting Students

TWIN FALLS – The College of Southern Idaho received a Department of Education Child Care Access Means Parents In School (CCAMPIS) Grant in October. The grant, just shy of \$240,000, will be spread over a four-year period to provide an opportunity for currently enrolled parenting students to gain access to funds that will help cover child care costs.

“We are very excited about this grant because it will help students who are parents better afford child care costs which can be a barrier for those who would like to return to, or begin, their college education,” John Hughes, CSI Instructional Dean, said.

Students interested in applying must fill out one of the following child care scholarship award applications and submit it to the CSI Financial Aid/Scholarship Office on the main campus in Twin Falls by January 9, 2019:
