



## **GOODING COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY**

### **DRUG FREE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship has been established by the Gooding County Prosecutor to recognize an outstanding, drug free, financially challenged senior within Gooding County who is committed to higher education and public service.

It is the intent of this one-year scholarship to be given to a worthy Gooding County senior each year. This is a \$1000 dollar scholarship that will be applied \$500 the first semester and \$500 the second.

**ELEGIBILITY:** Students graduating in the upcoming spring from any high school in Gooding County are eligible to apply. The applicant must be a Gooding County resident at the time of the application, must attend the College of Southern Idaho full-time (at least 12 credits per semester) the upcoming academic year, and must be enrolled in an academic or vocational program leading to a degree or certification. Students related within the first degree to any employee of the Gooding Prosecuting Attorney's Office may not apply.

#### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

1. A completed application form (attached)
2. A 1000 word essay, double space with 12 point font on the subject of "What can be done within Gooding County to reduce the use and sale of illegal drugs."

3. A 3.0 to 4.0 G.P.A. as shown on an official transcript from your high school and any colleges you may have received credit from.
4. Applicants do not need to be currently enrolled, but must apply for admission to CSI as a full-time student. Any student who does not attend CSI will forfeit the scholarship to the next most eligible applicant.
5. On a separate sheet of paper, please list and specifically describe the following:
  - a. Honors and awards;
  - b. Leadership positions;
  - c. School and community involvement, including volunteer activities; and service club participation;
  - d. A statement of financial need;
  - e. A statement of what career you are pursuing and why as well as your goals within that career choice.
6. A signed Drug Free Pledge (attached). Any violation of this Pledge will nullify any remaining scholarship funds.
7. Two sealed letters of recommendation from individuals not related to you. One such letter shall be from a teacher, counselor, or administrator of your high school.
8. Selected finalists will be required to give a five-minute presentation related to their essay to the Prosecutor's Office at a time and date to be announced later.
