NEW BUSINESS

- **Mo- Senate and Unity**

- **Bylaws Proposal**
 - **Braydon purposed to add a clause 3 to Section 12 of Article 1 stating “The reports may be turned in up to seven calendar days after the initial due date resulting in a late fee established by Rules Committee, after seven days the reports will no longer be accepted and the hours for that week will no longer be considered resulting in deductions for the incomplete hours on the report.”**
 - **It was brought to a unanimous agreement with a straw pull at 5:53 pm.**
 - **Hasan moved to suspend the one week waiting period and was seconded by Skylar at 5:57 pm and was passed with a unanimous vote.**
 - **Hasan moved to add the section 12 article 1 clause 3 and was seconded by Angel at 5:58 pm. This bylaw changed was unanimously passed.**
