## **Bill #2**

## By Senator Lawson

- 1. To establish a formula to regulate Special Events Funding for clubs recognized by ASCSI
- 2. And to encourage clubs to raise funds themselves to support their activities.
- 3. The Senate will match the money earned by the club for a one time, per fiscal year,
- 4. (Excluding Program Board or Interclub money) for a maximum of \$1,500.
  - The Senate will only match what a club earns to a maximum of \$1,500 (i.e. club earns \$650, the maximum amount of cash awarded will be \$650 by the Senate)
  - Merit of the proposal can affect the amount of money given to a club either positively of negatively.
- 5. The Special Events Funding will be given to clubs once it is passed before the Senate
- 6. With a Majority Vote.
- 7. This bill may be amended to supply clubs with additional funds in the course of
- 8. Insufficient funds for a club activity, as long as the following criteria is met:
  - The Special Events Fund Budget can allow the additional money
  - If it is approved by the Executive Committee
  - If it passes in front of the Senate with a Super Majority Vote (2/3)
- 9. This Bill shall be in full force and in effect on and after November 10, 2008.
