TO THE ADMINISTRATION AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO REGARDING THE RECOGNITION OF CLUBS AND ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, the current Student Association policy states that clubs are student led and are not obligated to belong to a certain department, but rather reflect student interests, and

WHEREAS, Student Association clubs receive student association funds that are used to support club activities and operations, and

WHEREAS, Student Association clubs are obligated to follow Student Association and institution policy for recognition, and

WHEREAS, certain clubs are an extension of the corresponding curriculum and are not initiated by student interest, and

WHEREAS, these clubs are led primarily by college employees and follow rules and policy developed by college departments, and

WHEREAS, these institutional clubs are important to programs, yet do not follow Student Association philosophy,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASCSI SENATE, ACTING AS REPRESENTATIVES OF CURRENT STUDENTS OF THE COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO, THAT WE RECOMMEND TO THE ADMINISTRATION AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO APPROVE THE DESIGNATION OF STUDENT ASSOCIATION CLUBS AND INSTITUTIONAL ORGANIZATIONS AS SEPARATE ENTITIES WITH DIFFERENT OPERATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY FOR FUNDING.
