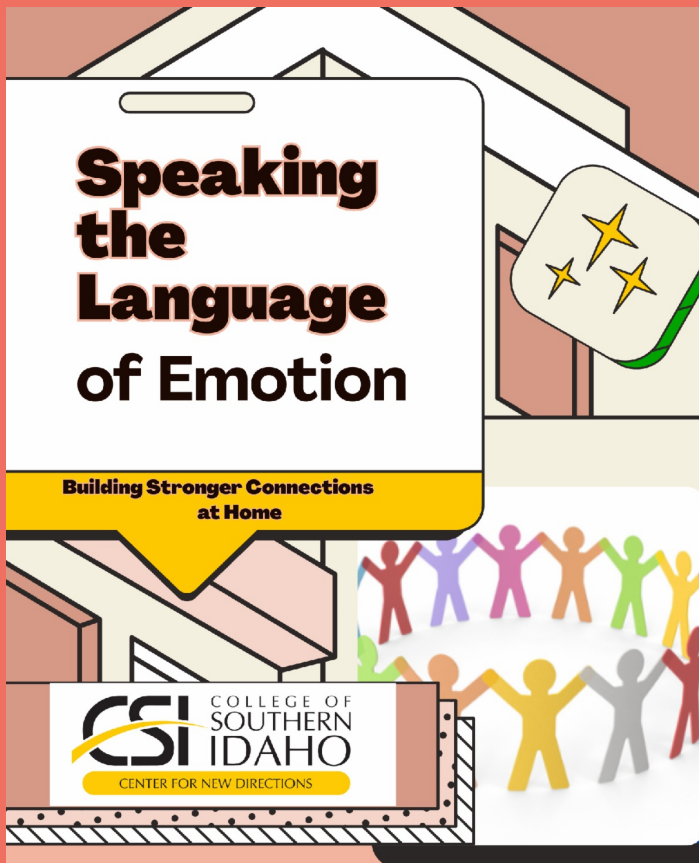

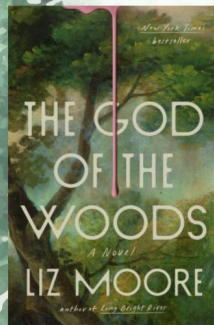

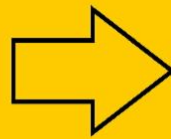
## **Rec Center Work Study Position Open**
