#### Do I have to work every day?

#### Can substitutes choose the grade level(s) to work?

Yes, if you have experience we will work with you based on your comfort level. You can select which school and which grades you would prefer.

#### What is the pay rate?

The pay rate for most substitute teaching positions is approximately \$1000 per day depending on qualifications.
