



### The Prize

Three (3) winning student authors and the featured faculty members, staff members, or administrators in the winning essays will each receive travel to The NISOD Conference: Advancing Community College Student Engagement (ACCSE) (May 23-26, 2026 in Austin, Texas), which includes:

- Up to \$400 USD toward travel to Austin, Texas;


