It can be extremely difficult to find words to express the emotions we feel when faced with events like the violent deaths of the four students at the University of Idaho. Death is never easy, but when young people lose lives so full of promise, it is truly tragic. Sadly, we must endure senseless acts of violence all too often in our society, and when those acts directly impact communities to which we are connected, the blow is even more severe.

During times like these, we learn about the true power of *community*. Gathering together allows us to lean on each other for comfort and for support. In that spirit, CSI Student Body President Aurora Berumen Ortiz and I invite you to come together at the Tower at the center of campus **tomorrow, Tuesday, November 29, at 5:30 pm** to participate in a candlelight vigil in honor of, and in memory of, the students who lost their lives at the University of Idaho. We'll take a few moments to gather, to remember, and to collectively express both our grief and our support. Opportunities will also be available for you to record written expressions of sympathy to the University of Idaho community, and I'll make sure those are passed along.

Let us each be a Vandal Tuesday evening. Please wear any University of Idaho apparel you have and join us to show solidarity with the U of I community. In the

meantime, I encourage you to reach out to those you may know in the Vandal community and support them.

The late Rabbi Earl Grollman perhaps said it best when he said that “grief is not a disorder, a disease, or a sign of weakness. It is an emotional, physical, and spiritual necessity, the price you pay for love. The only cure for grief is to grieve.” While we might not have known the students personally, we can join as a community to grieve their loss.

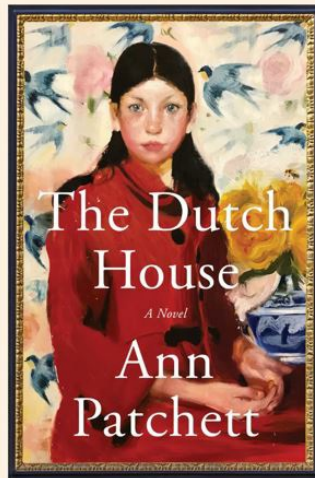
