





To complete the FAFSA you must have the following:

- FSA ID (<u>fsaid.ed.gov</u>) for student & one parent (dependent students)
- Student & parent's Federal 1040 Income Tax Return, including Schedules 1, 2, & 3
- Student & parent's W2s, 1099's or form Schedule C
- Parent's social security number, birth date, marital status, & marital date (dependent students only)
- · Eligible non-citizens permanent resident card

The 2023-2024 FAFSA application requires 2021 income information.








