At this time there is no limit to the number of images that an artist can submit, but please submit visual art in JPG or PNG format no larger than 25 MB. For performance videos such as dramatic readings, dance, and music performances, please post your video to YouTube and then submit the link. The maximum length is eight minutes. We accept submissions year-round, but to be included in each year's issue, please submit by March 1, 2024.


