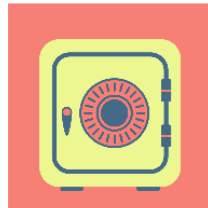
MISSION STATEMENT

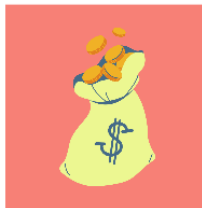

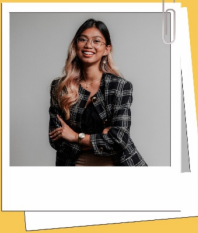
