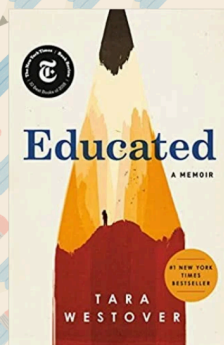

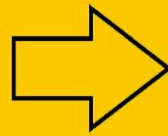


## Admissions Work-Study

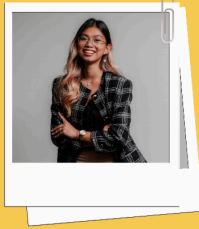
