Snake River Plain Chapter Commander Miguel Dominic and Senior Vice Commander Wade Pierce presented President Jeff Fox with the plaque Monday during a college board meeting. "By becoming a Purple Heart College you are honoring the sacrifices of those who have served our nation and those who were wounded or killed in action," Dominic stated.

Dominic said there a hundreds of Purple Heart cities across the county. During the presentation, Fox read a proclamation recognizing the history of the Purple Heart and in support of those who've served and those who've been wounded while serving in the armed forces. The proclamation affirmed the college's support of those attend and work on the campus.

Last year, the city of Twin Falls was designated a Purple Heart city, and signs were posted at the city's five entrances. Military veterans in attendance were asked to be recognized during the ceremony. Members of the college student senate also attended the presentation. College of Southern Idaho becomes a Purple Heart College 4/17/2017 Twin Falls, Idaho.


